

## Privacy notice for data subjects that use UC AB data services on behalf of their employer

This privacy notice describes the processing of personal data by UC AB concerning data subjects who use UC data services or who report on ESG matters on behalf of their employer.

### 2. Personal data which is processed

- Your name (not collected from users of webservice pool)
- Your ID number (only when using BankID)
- Your email address
- Your phone number (only when it is needed to use the service)
- Your service user ID (not collected from users of webservice pool)
- Your role and title
- Recordings of the phone calls with you (you will be separately informed about recording)

When you visit our websites we will collect e.g.

- data concerning purchases
- data about how you use our website
- technical data concerning your browser and your IP address

### 3. Purposes for processing your personal data

We process your personal data

- to be able to manage the access rights and use of the services or to process ESG-data reported by you concerning the company you represent
- to invoice the company you represent
- for marketing purposes and for customer communications
- to comply with legislation, e.g. bookkeeping and tax legislation
- to send you possible customer feedback survey after you've contacted us or were appointed as the user of a service on behalf of your employer

### 4. Legal basis for processing your personal data

We process your personal data based on GDPR 6.1 f and the legitimate interest of UC, also to send you possible customer feedback survey. Your personal data will also be processed based on GDPR article 6.1 c to comply with regulatory requirements. We may also contact you concerning new products and services based on you filling in a lead form at our partners website and giving separate consent, here legal basis for processing your data is GDPR art 6.1 a.

### 5. Special categories of personal data and personal data relating to criminal convictions and offences

We don't process sensitive category personal data or data relating to criminal convictions and offences concerning you.

### 6. Collection of your personal data

We collect the following personal data concerning you from your employer

- Your name
- Contact details
- Information about your role and title

We collect your personal data from you when you contact us or register to use a service. You can give your contact details to us by filling in a form on our website, buying a service or contacting us by e.g. calling or by using chat on the website.

## 7. Third parties that we disclose your personal data to inside EU/EEA

Your personal data may be disclosed to our processors to be processed on our behalf.

## 8. Transfers of personal data outside EU/EEA area

Your personal data may in some situations be disclosed outside EU/EEA area for example to the processors we use. In these situations we ensure that your personal data is secured to an adequate level. We also use Standard Contractual Clauses and other measures to protect your personal data.

## 9. Profiling and automated decision-making

UC does not process your personal data for profiling or automated decision-making purposes.

## 10. Retention periods

We will remove your personal data after becoming aware that you no longer use UC services on behalf of your employer. If the contract with your employer and UC is terminated some of your personal data may still be kept for 12 months due to a regulatory requirement.

User data collected by website cookies will be kept for 12 to 14 months.

## 11. Your rights

You as the data subject whose personal data UC is processing, have several different data subject rights towards us as the controller. Below you will find information on how to exercise these rights. We will process your request and respond to your request without undue delay and in any event within one month of receipt of the request.

- **Right to information**

- You will receive the privacy notice when you start using our products or services
- If phone call with you is recorded, you will be separately informed about this at the beginning of the call.

- **Right of access**

- **Right to rectification**

If you want to request rectification of incorrect personal data concerning you, please send an email to [info@uc.se](mailto:info@uc.se) or call us at **08-670 90 00**.

- **Right to erasure**

- If you want to request erasure of personal data concerning you please send an email to [info@uc.se](mailto:info@uc.se) or call us at **08-670 90 00**.
- We will remove your personal data based on your request and you will no longer be able to use UC services after that or report ESG-data on behalf of this company.

- **Right to restriction of processing**

If you want to request restriction of processing of your personal data please send an email to [info@uc.se](mailto:info@uc.se) or call us at **08-670 90 00**.

- **Right to data portability**

You don't have the right to data portability, since UC is not processing your personal data based on consent or for performance of contract between you and UC.

- **Right to object**

- You have the right to object, on grounds to your particular situation, the processing of your personal data which is based on public interest (art 6.1 e) or legitimate interest (art 6.1 f).
